### **THE NATIONAL CIVIC REMEMBRANCE DAY SERVICE: 11 NOVEMBER 2012**

The 92<sup>nd</sup> Annual National Civic Remembrance Day Service and Parade will take place on Sunday 11 November 2012, at 14:00 at Cenotaph, Harrison Street, Johannesburg. In this event, there will be a wreath laying ceremony as well. The City of Johannesburg will pay tribute to the South Africans who lost their lives in honour of South Africa. Since 1995 this ceremony and service pay tribute to those patrons who lost their lives to establish democratic order in South Africa.

The Executive Mayor of Johannesburg, Councillor Parks Tau, will be the main functionary. Military guests will also attend the event.

The parade will consist of the SANDF Regular and Reserve Forces elements, SAPS, JHB Metro Police Detachments, JHB Emergency Services Detachments, Ex-Service organisations including the Gunners Association, Ex MK, APLA, AZANLA, SA Infantry Association, Royal Naval Association and SA Air Force Association, element of the Youth Volunteer Organisations viz. SA Red Cross, Noodhulpliga, Boys Scouts, Girl Guides, School children and Fire Engines.

The parade will start with the trooping of various bands and then the marching columns will march past the Cenotaph, Harrison Street. Thereafter the Remembrance Day Service and wreath laying ceremony will take place.
