**THE SANDF RECEIVES THE MORTAL REMAINS OF ONE OF ITS MEMBERS WHO WENT MISSING IN NAMIBIA**

The South African National Defence Force (SANDF) announces with sadness that the body which was found on Sunday 03 November 2013 in Namibian waters, was positively identified to be that of Sergeant Senatla Abel Sebooa from 4 South African Special Forces Regiment.

The member went missing at sea during the military exercise at Sandwich Harbour in Walvis Bay, Namibia. The Special Forces were involved in a Southern African Development Community multinational force preparation exercise dubbed, WELWITCHIA.

The SANDF will hold the Receiving of Mortal Remains Parade at Air Force Base Waterkloof on Monday 18 November 2013 at 10:00.
