SUBJECT: CHANGES ON SOUTH AFRICAN AIR FORCE RHINO DAY INITIATIVE

The South African Air Force's "Rhino Day Initiative" Auction event scheduled for 20 September 2013 at Air Force Base Waterkloof Officers Mess, will now take place on **25 September 2013 from 10:30 at Air Force Base Waterkloof Officers Mess**.

The ten (10) best judged rhino statues during a decorating competition, the original rhino sculpture "Rocco" along with eight (8) oil paintings of Rhinos will be auctioned off during a function on the day.

The South African Air Force has embarked on a month long campaign to signify its environmental obligations specifically in the Air Force Base Waterkloof's satellite unit of Ditholo Training Area, which forms part of Dinokeng Big Five Game Reserve situated near Hammanskraaal.
