Historically the South African Navy and other arms of services advertise for Military Development System (MSD) annually on national newspapers as well as on their websites. Attached fake SA Navy application form currently in circulation and a legitimate form (more or less how it would resemble).

Members of the public are warned to report any fraudulent activities to the police.
